## **2024/2025/2026 Tune Requirements**

## **Background Information:**

Following comprehensive investigation and consultation, it has become evident that there is a diversity in solo piping tune requirements across all our branches. Additionally, some branches delegate solo piping competition organization to independent piping societies.

In addition to varied tune requirements, Australia faces a disparity in grading standards, notably in Novice, D, C, and B Grades.

The implementation of standardized tune requirements aims to enhance the overall standard of solo piping throughout the nation. This initiative allows pipers from one branch to competently participate in contests hosted by another branch, ensuring familiarity with the tune requirements and fair competition against players of similar grades.

While these tune requirements are obligatory for solo piping contests organized by Pipe Band Australia, they do not prohibit promoters/branches from organizing specialized events. The Lachie McCabe U18 contest at MacLean serves as an example of such events.

It is hoped that independent piping societies, though not obligated to adhere to these tune requirements, will recognize their benefits and significance, eventually adopting them for the advancement of solo piping in Australia.

# **Light Music**

#### A Grade

Element  $1 - 1 \times 2/4$  March of 4 or more parts (Submit 3 tunes)

Element 2 - 1 x Strathspey of 4 or more parts *into* 1 x Reel of 4 or more parts (submit 3 of each tune)

Element 3 - 1 x Hornpipe of 4 parts *into* 1 x jig of 4 or more parts (Submit 3 of each tune)

Element  $4 - 2 \times 6/8$  March of 4 or more parts (submit 3 tunes)

Element 5 - 2x Jigs of 4 or more parts (submit 3 tunes)

Promotors are advised that a minimum of 3 events should be conducted at each contest. Elements 1 & 2 are compulsory and element 3, 4 or 5 can be selected/interchanged as the 3rd event. Elements 1 & 2 can be combined into a MSR or run separately. This would be at the promotor's discretion.

#### **B** Grade

Element  $1 - 1 \times 2/4$  March of 4 or more parts (Submit 2 tunes)

Element 2 - 1 x Strathspey of 4 or more parts *into* 1 x Reel of 4 or more parts (Submit 2 of each tune)

Element 3 - 1 x Hornpipe of 4 parts *into* 1 x jig of 4 or more parts (Submit 2 of

Element  $4 - 1 \times 6/8$  March of 4 or more parts (submit 2 tunes)

Promotors are advised that a minimum of 3 events should be conducted at each contest. Elements 1 & 2 are compulsory and element 3 & 4 can be selected/interchanged as the 3rd event.

#### C Grade

Element  $1 - 1 \times 2/4$  March of 4 or more parts

Element 2 - 1 x Strathspey of 4 or more parts *into* 1 x Reel of 4 or more parts

Element 3 - 1 x jig of 4 or more parts

Element  $4 - 1 \times 6/8$  March of 4 or more parts

Promotors are advised that a minimum of 3 events should be conducted at each contest. Elements 1 & 2 are compulsory and element 3 & 4 can be selected/interchanged as the 3rd event.

#### **D** Grade

Element  $1 - 1 \times 2/4$  March of 4 or more parts (can be  $2 \times 2$  parted tunes)

Element 2 - 1 x Strathspey of 2 or more parts *into* 1 x Reel of 2 or more parts

Element 3 - 1 x Slow Air of 24 bars or more

Element  $4 - 1 \times 6/8$  March of 4 or more parts (can be  $2 \times 2$  parted tunes)

Promotors are advised that a minimum of 2 events should be conducted at each contest. Element 1 is compulsory and elements 2, 3 & 4 can be selected/interchanged as the 2nd event.

#### **Novice**

Element  $1 - 1 \times 2/4$  March of 2 or more parts

Element  $2 - 1 \times \text{Slow Air}$ 

### **Beginner Practice Chanter Event**

Element 1 – Any tune on the practice chanter

## U18 as at the day of the contest

Element  $1 - 1 \times 2/4$  March of 4 or more parts

### Veterans over 50 as at the day of the contest

Element  $1 - 1 \times 2/4$  March of 4 or more parts

## **Piobaireachd**

As part of our commitment to improving the standard and ongoing development of Piobaireachd, Australia will adopt The Piobaireachd Society Silver Medals Set Tunes. This concept aims to support pipers planning to compete internationally while also growing the knowledge and understanding of Piobaireachd in Australia. It is recommended that pipers join the Piobaireachd Society for information on the set tunes as a starting point.

It is acknowledged that this will be a difficult process to commence, and it is hoped that Pipers will embrace this new concept. It will take effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2024. Please review the Set tune Implementation Timeline.

#### A Grade

Submit 3 full tunes including crunluath variation and crunluath a'mach where applicable.

Competitors are required to select a minimum of 1 tune from the list supplied and the balance can be their own choice. Competitors are not restricted to scores from the Kilberry or Piobaireachd Society. Competitors should submit a copy of the music when approaching the adjudicator.

This will take effect from 1st July 2024.

#### **B** Grade

Submit 2 full tunes including crunluath variation and crunluath a'mach where applicable.

Competitors are required to select a minimum of 1 tune from the list supplied and the balance can be their own choice. Competitors are not restricted to scores of the Kilberry or Piobaireachd Society books. Competitors should submit a copy of the music when approaching the adjudicator.

This will take effect from 1st July 2024.

## C Grade

Submit 1 full tune including crunluath variation and crunluath a'mach where applicable.

#### D Grade

Ground and next variation only.

Note: If the tune has a ground followed by thumb variation or ground doubling then this is all that needs to be played. If the tune has a ground, then Variation 1, then this is all that needs to be played.

#### **Novice**

Ground only

#### Veterans over 50 as at the day of the contest

Submit 1 full tune including crunluath variation and crunluath a'mach where applicable.

## **Set Tune List Implementation Timeline**

1<sup>st</sup> of July 2024 Set Tunes released.
 A minimum of 1 tune from the 2024 or 2025 Set
 Tune list to be submitted by A & B Grade Pipers for all competitions.

1<sup>st</sup> of December, a minimum of 2 tunes from the 2024/2025 list to be submitted by **A Grade Pipers** at all contests run under Pipe Bands Australia rules. **B Grade Pipers** will submit 1 tune from the 2024/2025 Set Tune list at all competitions.

1<sup>st</sup> of December 2025, the 2026 Set Tunes from the Piobaireachd Society Gold & Silver list implemented.
 A minimum of 2 tunes for A Grade Pipers and 1 tune for B Grade Pipers from the Set Tune list will be expected to be submitted for all competitions.

1<sup>st</sup> of December 2026, the 2027 Set Tunes from the Piobaireachd Society Gold & Silver list implemented.
A minimum of 2 tunes for A Grade Pipers and 1 tune for B Grade Pipers from the Set Tune list will be expected to be submitted for all competitions.

Element 3 - 1 x Hornpipe of 4 parts *into* 1 x jig of 4 or more parts (Submit 3 of each tune)

Elements 1 & 2 can be combined into a MSR or run separately. This would be at the promotor's discretion.

#### A Grade Piobaireachd

Submit 4 full tunes including crunluath variation and crunluath a'mach where applicable.

For 2024, competitors are required to select a minimum of 1 tune from the list supplied and the balance can be their own choice. Competitors are not restricted to scores of the Kilberry or Piobaireachd Society books. Competitors should submit a copy of the music when approaching the adjudicator.

Element 3 - 1 x Hornpipe of 4 parts *into* 1 x jig of 4 or more parts (Submit 3 of each tune)

Elements 1 & 2 can be combined into a MSR or run separately. This would be at the promotor's discretion.

#### A Grade Piobaireachd

Submit 4 full tunes including crunluath variation and crunluath a'mach where applicable.

Competitors are required to select a minimum of 2 tune from the list supplied and the balance can be their own choice. Competitors are not restricted to scores of the Kilberry or Piobaireachd Society books. Competitors should submit a copy of the music when approaching the adjudicator.
